The Accessibility Services Office at SUNY Adirondack is committed to providing students with disabilities with an equal opportunity to benefit from all of its programs, services, and activities by providing access, reasonable accommodations, and effective communication in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendment Act of 2008 (ADAAA), Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) and section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
