- BUS 178** - 2nd year student & permission of instructor
- BUS 201** - Not open to first year students

- BUS 203** – BUS 101 and BUS 103
- BUS 204** – BUS 103
- BUS 206** - BUS 146 or (146A & B) with a “C” or better
