- 2. <u>Ensembles</u> must correspond to the major area of focus as designated by the Music Department. Admittance into performing ensembles is at the discretion of the appropriate conductor/coach. Four credits must be in a large ensemble appropriate to the primary instrument. Four credits must be in a small ensemble appropriate to the primary instrument.
