- Students shall meet with their assigned advisor and discuss program requirements of the transfer institution in selecting their mathematics, liberal arts and sciences and elective coursework. This degree conforms to these **SUNY Transfer Paths:**
  - BUSINESS** MAT 131 is recommended, but required for junior status at many major SUNY Universities.
  - ECONOMICS** MAT 121 and MAT 125 are required; MAT 131 is recommended.
  - HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT** BUS 193 (Spring only) and BUS 265 (Fall only) shall be taken as the elective credit.
  - SPORT MANAGEMENT** See Individual Studies AS Sport Management concentration
- Recommended electives are MAT 127, SPH 111 and foreign languages.
